TLT REQUIREMENTS

- Proper Uniform at every meeting. Check with Grace or Perry if you are not sure.
- Attendance at every club meeting and Pathfinder leaders meetings. Call Grace or Perry if you are not able to attend.
- Treat each other, other counselors, and the Pathfinders with respect.
- Follow the Pathfinder Pledge and Law.
- Keep a daily devotional.
- Continue in AY Classwork. Once the Guide class work is complete, you are expected to work on your Masterguide class work.

PATHFINDER MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- Ten to fifteen years is the official age for Pathfinder membership.
- Club activities include crafts, outings, regular club meetings and fundraising campaigns, and the Pathfinder must agree before joining the club.
- Members must be faithful in attendance.
- The Pathfinder's parents must be willing to cooperate with the regulations and activities of the club. At times they will be asked to supply money and time to support their child's membership.
- All members must pay club dues on a yearly basis.
- Each pathfinder should own and regularly wear a complete Pathfinder uniform. He must come to meetings and club sponsored events in full uniform, as advised by the club director.
- Pathfinders are expected to obey all regulations, instructions, and orders of the Pathfinder staff
- Club member must be willing to participate in community projects. Share Your Faith and Outreach programs.
- Children will be expected to participate and cooperate in all conference events.
- Pathfinders must learn and keep the AY Pledge and Law.
- Pathfinders must learn the Pathfinder song.

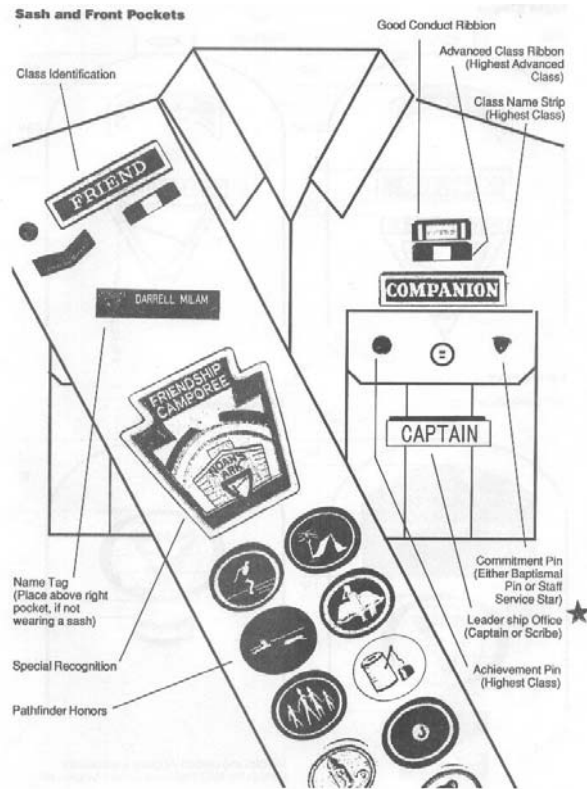

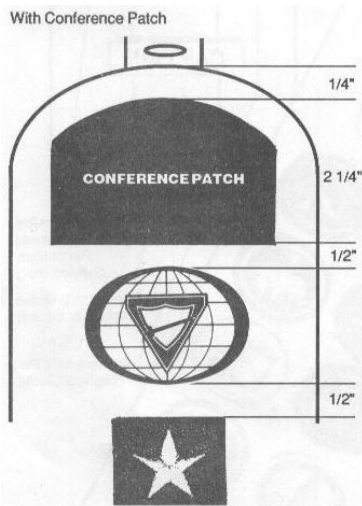


PATHFINDER CLUB PATHFINDER UNIFORM LAYOUT

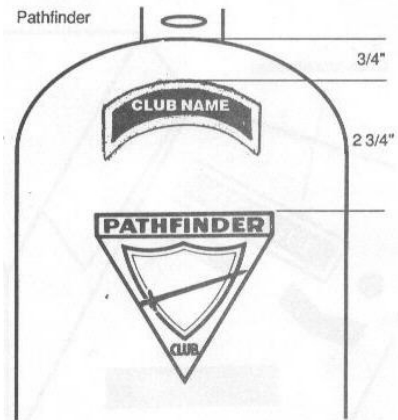

EXPECTATIONS OF LEADERS 2007



CORE LEADERS (Assistant Directors)

AY Coordinators (TBD, Ebenesar, Philip)

- Keep track of overall progress of AY Classes
- Call AY Teachers to remind them of dates of meetings
- If you see an AY teacher struggling, give them pointers and suggestions on things to do.
- Give them a general outline of things to cover at each AY Meeting so that they complete the work by the end of the year.
- Work with outdoor activity coordinator for honors your AY classes need to complete.
- Let Jonathan know of patches that need to be ordered.
- Cover for any absent AY teachers.

Finance (Jonathan)

- Keep track of club finances
- Provide monthly report to core leaders and church treasurer listing expenses, budget, and how we are doing to estimated budget.
- Collect all money and give to church treasurer (Mrs. Pulidindi) or pastors
- Order patches for honors that have been completed.

Outdoor coordinators (Jonathan)

- Arrange transportation for all events (outings, camps, and other field trips) – contact responsible drivers to drive for trips.
- Work with AY coordinators to complete honors needed for AY classes.
- Make sure church van is reserved (talk to Uncle Selvakumar) for all Pathfinder events.
- Make sure all vehicles have at least 1 working 2-way radio and that all radios are set to the same channel.
- Make sure at least one first aid kit is taken for all trips.

Honors Coordinators for Sunday Meetings (Sabina)

- Coordinate honors for the Sunday meetings
- Call teachers of meetings to remind them of meetings
- Make sure teachers have all the supplies they need.
- Let Jonathan know of patches that need to be ordered.

Ladies/Mens Coordinators

- Schedule/run the overall meetings (Start, end, allot time for each activity)
- Keep track of points for units through the year
- Call pathfinders on regular basis (Coordinators need to call same sex pathfinders)
- Call counselors and make sure they are calling the pathfinders in their unit
- Call counselors with meeting changes

Religious Events (Sylvester)

- Plan worships for each meetings
- Work with AY teachers to schedule worships
- Plan religious activities for SASDAC camp
- Work with core leaders, TLT's, and counselors to plan Inductions, Pathfinder Sabbath, and Investiture.

COUNSELORS

- Call Pathfinders in unit every week to see how they are doing
- Relay changes to schedules to pathfinders in unit. Make sure they speak to someone from each household.
- Spend time with pathfinders in unit
- Attend AY classes with Pathfinders and help get supplies for AY Teachers
- Let Directors know if there are any issues that come up.
- Since positive Christian role modeling is your primary task, it is critical that your lifestyle and what you do outside of Pathfinders follows what we are teaching. If you are not able to do this, please speak to Ben, Deepa, Grace, or Perry.

AY TEACHERS

- Come prepared to teach for 1 ½ hours. Most days you will have just over 1 hour but come prepared with extra material.
- Let your AY coordinator know if you will not be able to make it to a meeting.
- Have an overall plan for the year.
- Let AY coordinator know of honors that need to be worked on or honors that are complete.
- Let AY coordinator know of special supplies you will need for a meeting if you are not able to get the supplies yourself.
- Ask for help if you need it.
- Make the class fun (It's truly possible).
